The objects of the University shall be to promote and develop Hindi language and literature in general and, for that purpose, to provide for instructional and research facilities in the relevant branches of learning; to provide for active pursuit of comparative studies and research in Hindi and other Indian languages. Hence candidates having experience in teaching and or able to teach in Hindi Medium need only apply.
2. For teaching post candidate must filled up and attached Academic Performance Indicator (API) based Performance Based Performance Based Appraisal System (PBAS) along with application form. (Annexure – III), Otherwise their application summarily rejected.
3. Those who have already applied for the post of Professor (Translation Technology), Professor (Machine Translation – ST), Professor (Mass Media – Gen), Professor (Language Technology – SC), Associate Professor (Laboratory in Information and Liberal Arts (Lila)-Gen., Assistant Professor (Japanese) through the Adv. No. MGAHV/07/2011, dated 09.09.2011 & Associate Professor (Comparative Literature-Gen) through the Adv. No. MGAHV/02/2011, dated 25.05.2011 need not apply again.
4. All applicants must fulfil the essential qualifications of the post and other conditions stipulated in the advertisement. They are advised to satisfy themselves before applying that they possess at least the essential qualifications laid down for various posts.
