The form of caste certificate to be provided by the OBC candidates must in the format as prescribed by the GOI, otherwise, the application will be similarly rejected without further consideration.
- 8. A relaxation of 5% shall be provided, from 55% to 50% of marks at the master's level for the SC/ST Category (for all posts).
- 9. A relaxation of 5% shall be provided, from 55% to 50% of the marks to the Ph.D. degree holders who have passed their Master's degree prior to 19th Sept. 1991.
- 10. B in the Seven Point Scale with letter grades O, A, B, C, D, E & F shall be regarded as equivalent of 55% where the grading system is followed.
- 11. Candidates selected will be on probation for a period of one year for group A post & two years for others.
- 12. The employees of Central/State Govt./PSUs/Corporations etc. must apply through proper channel in the prescribed form and should submit NOC at the time of interview, otherwise, their candidature will not be considered.
- 13. If any time before or after of the selection of a candidate, it is found that any information is false or suppressed, his selection will be liable to be cancelled.
