Mahatma Gandhi Antarrashtriya Hindi Viswavidyalaya, Wardha, Maharashtra, India (Mahatma Gandhi International Hindi University) was established in 1997 by the Govt. of India under an act of Parliament. President of India is the Visitor of this Central University.

The main objective of the University is to develop and promote Hindi as a world language. Hindi is not just a language used in day to day life or just a medium of creative writing. It is a language used by a large section of humanity in India and abroad, which is positioning itself not only as a powerful medium of knowledge dissemination but is also emerging as a means of knowledge creation in various disciplines of study. MGAHV is striving to make Hindi a language of frontier knowledge areas.

MGAHV wishes to offer short term Hindi courses specially designed for international students. The courses are structured in such a way that the proficiency is attained alongwith the imbibe ment of Indian ethos and traditions which may help the students becoming a world citizen.



ONE YEAR DIPLOMA IN HINDI AS AN INTERNATIONAL LANGUAGE

THREE MONTHS SHORT TERM CERTIFICATE PROGRAMME FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

Students from abroad having elementary knowledge of Hindi will be admitted to this programme.

The first month will solely be utilised for learning Hindi language in a scientific way by using all sorts of modern teaching tools.

The second and the third month will be utilised for different branches of learning-

- Structure and Use of Hindi Language.
- Introduction to Hindi Language Technology
- Introduction to Hindi Literature
- Introduction to Indian Diaspora Studies
- Introduction to Hindi Film and Theater Studies

Note : Students can opt for any one of the branches of study.

There are two slots for the programme:

First slot	September to November
Second slot	December to February

STUDY FEE

The total monthly expenditure for an International student is **US \$200** This includes : Tuition fee, International Student's Hostel Accommodation (A/c Room), food (three times), water and electricity charges, Local conveyance with in the campus, Internet and Gym facility etc.



STUDENTS EXCHANGE PROGRAMME

Mahatma Gandhi International Hindi University also welcomes students of foreign universities, who are interested in learning Hindi, for short visits. This is a sort of exchange programme through which the students will get benefitted by interacting with the university students, faculty members and staying with Hindi speaking families.

The interested group of students or individual students of any foreign university may contact Mahatma Gandhi International Hindi University for this purpose between July and April.

The duration fixed for this programme may be one week / two or three weeks.

SANDWICH PROGRAMME FOR RESEARCHERS

Those students who are seriously engaged in Research activities related to any branch of studies in Hindi language or literature may feel free to visit Mahatma Gandhi International Hindi University for pursuing their research for a shorter period or for 3 to 6 months. Through this short visit they can enrich their vistas of knowledge in the campus.

STAY

Accommodation is offered in Father Camille Bulcke International Hostel. The hostel provides all essential facilities to make the stay comfortable. Meals are also prepared considering the international standards.

ACADEMICS

The classes are engaged by experienced teachers of different branches of study. Experts from other institutions and universities are also invited for this purpose. Tutorials are arranged for students for effective interaction.

HOW TO REACH WARDHA

By Air: Nagpur is the nearest airport to Wardha. It is situated about 70 kms from the university campus and there are direct flights available from Delhi, Mumbai, Kolkata, etc.

By Train: Indian Railways have a wide network in Wardha District. There are trains from places like Delhi, Mumbai, Kolkata and other major Indian stations which halt at Wardha and Sewagram railway stations.

PLACES OF INTEREST

In the vicinity of Wardha, where the University is situated, there are two Ashrams (Hermitages) namely, 'Bapukuti' at Sewagram and 'Paramdham Ashram' at Pavnar. Mahatma Gandhi lived at Sewagram ashram for the last 13 years of his life leading the freedom movement from here. Vinoba Bhave, a close disciple of Mahatma Gandhi founded other ashram on the bank of Dham river. The University arranges free visits to these ashrams.

World Heritage Sites like Ajanta Caves with paintings on Buddhist themes, dating back to 2nd century B.C. and Ellora Caves dating back to 5th Century A.D., representing the epitome of Indian rock-cut architecture are at a distance of 400 kms from Wardha. Trips can be arranged for the students on payment.



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
