I am further directed to say that since the University is in its formative stage and it does not have its proper campus developed so far, therefore, it would be desirable to sanction these posts in phases. To begin with the UGC has agreed to sanction 25% of the posts requested i.e. total 61 posts. The University may decide the allocation of these posts on the basis of its priority. University may approach UGC for further sanction of the posts, as and when, they feel they have created infrastructural facilities to house them properly and engage them in academic activities in a meaningful way. The details of the 61 posts allocated may be sent to UGC.

The University will follow the reservation policy of the Government of India for Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes and OBC to the extent of 22.5% and 27% respectively in all non-teaching posts and 22.5% for Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes in the teaching posts of Lecturers (Asstt. Professor) only.



Kindly recall that we had a meeting with you on 19th May, 2006 to consider the revised plan proposals submitted by your university within plan allocation made by the Commission for the year 2006-07.

2. Based on the priorities indicated by you and suggestions made in the meetings held in the MHRD and in UGC, the Commission has approved the revised plan for utilization of allocated amount of Rs.21.00 crores as per details given in Annexure-I.

3. As was decided in the meeting, any committed liabilities under Xth Plan shall be accommodated within revised plan allocation for 2006-07. Further, the posts sanctioned now in the Xth Plan (Annexure-I) shall be treated as first-charge to the XIth Plan till it comes to end by 31st March, 2012.

4. Further to what we discussed in the meeting, I wish to draw your attention to a communication dated 9.5.2006 received from MHRD asking UGC "not to release the financial assistance under the plan funds for the 2nd quarter without obtaining a certification from each Central University to the effect that every vacancy in respect of post under direct recruitment/promotion by way of backlog reserved for SCs and STs have been duly advertised and filled". You are, therefore, requested to kindly identify the backlog vacancies to the extent of 22½% for SC and ST and advertise them to be filled up from among these categories. Needless to mention, UGC, in compliance of the Government of India's instructions, shall not be in position to release further instalments unless the instructions of Government of India are complied with in letter and spirit and UGC is informed of accordingly.

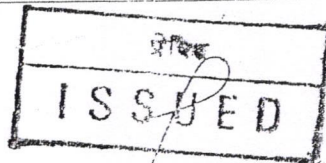
5. The Commission has already released one-third of allocated plan grant of your university for the year 2006-07 and as such, you are required to ensure that the utilization certificate of grants received by your university is submitted to the UGC on time so as to enable UGC to consider release of next instalment of course after meeting the stipulation made under para-4 above. As informed earlier, a flow chart for monthly plan expenditure may be conveyed to us in compliance of MHRD instructions.

6. Wishing you the best of utilization of funds and your endeavour to take the university forward.

The Government of India, MHRD vide letter No.F.3-2/2007-U.5 dated 27th May,2008 constituted an Empowered Committee in respect of each Central University to examine Detailed Project Reports (DPRs) prepared by the Central University concerned and to accord necessary clearance in the matter.

2. The Empowered Committee in its meeting held on 6th June,2008 in UGC office, after discussion with the representative of your University, has approved the tentative outlay for implementation of OBC Reservation as per the Central Educational Institutions (Reservation in Admission) Act, 2006 as detailed below:-

	(Rupees in Crores)

Recurring Grant includes five years expenditure on salary of teachers, non-teaching posts and non-salary/other expenditure etc.

Non-Recurring Grant includes augmentation of infrastructural facilities like laboratories, IT infrastructure, library facilities, hospitals beds (for medical colleges), equipments, construction of additional academic buildings, classrooms, hostels, houses for faculty and non-faculty etc.

The Commission in its meeting held on 18th-19th June, 2008 has approved the recommendations of Empowered Committee.

3. The abovementioned allocation is subject to fulfillment of the following conditions :-

- Teaching as also non-teaching positions on account of the proposed capacity expansion could be created by the Executive Council/Board of Management of the respective Universities provided the ratio for teaching and non-teaching posts after the proposed expansion would remain within the prescribed limit.
- In case the prescribed ratio for teaching and non-teaching posts do not permit creation of any more non-teaching posts, no non-teaching non-technical posts be created at this stage, while the genuine requirement of the Universities for such non-teaching technical positions as are considered to be essential for supporting teaching and research due to expansion programme will be considered by a Committee to be constituted for this purpose, which should include, inter-alia, a representative of the Ministry of Human Resource

Development. Further, the creation of these non-teaching technical positions should be synchronized in keeping with the phasing out plan for OBC reservation of each Central University.

- (iii) Once the teaching positions on account of the proposed capacity expansion have been filled by a Central University, its requirement for non-teaching non-technical posts will be examined by a Committee, which should include, inter-alia, a representative of the Ministry of Human Resource Development, in the light of the revised teaching-non teaching ratio. The sanction of non-teaching non-technical posts will be considered in very specific cases and that too after examining the overall position of the university with regard to sanctioned strength, existing strength, vacant positions and the area of requirement.
- (iv) The Universities have flexibility to plan their activities for augmentation of infrastructure and appointment of teaching staff during the first year. **However, the Universities may maintain separate account for recurring and non-recurring expenditure.** The position will be reviewed while releasing the second instalment during the current year.
- (v) University may follow strictly the Government of India/UGC's guidelines regarding implementation of the reservation policy [both vertical (for SCs, STs & OBCs) and horizontal (for persons with disability etc.)] in teaching and non-teaching posts.
- (vi) The release of grants is linked with the Reforms in Higher Education, as already conveyed by the Chairman, UGC vide D.O.letter No.F.1-2/2008 (XI Plan) dated 31st January,2008.
- (vii) **The interest accrued on the grant released by UGC for this purpose shall be utilized on this project / scheme only.**
- (viii) The policy of reservation for the OBCs under the Central Educational Institutions Act is to be implemented from the forthcoming academic session itself.
- (ix) The policy of reservation for the OBCs/SCs/STs under the CEI Act is applicable to all programmes / courses of study at the undergraduate, graduate, Post graduate levels, etc. except courses of programmes at high levels of specialization, including at the post-doctoral level within any branch of study which the Central Government in consultation with the appropriate statutory authority (UGC/BCI/ MCI/ AICTE, etc.) may specify. This is to reiterate that there shall be no exemption from the policy of reservation except where the Central government so specifies a course or programmes covered under clause (d) of Section 4 of the Act.

- (x) The reservation for the OBCs and SCs/STs under the CEI Act shall not apply to minority educational institutions as defined in section 2(f) of the Act as well as on CEIs established in areas coming under 6th Schedule of the Constitution.
- (xi) Each Central Educational Institution shall ensure that from among candidates belonging to the OBCs applying the admission against the seats reserved for the OBC category, information is collected from the candidates for exercising due diligence, so that no candidate belonging to the "creamy layer" is given the benefit of reservation for the OBCs.
- (xii) In order to identify and exclude candidates belonging to the "creamy layer" the criteria of exclusion / rules of exclusion have been provided in O.M. No.36012/22/93-(SCT), dated 8th September, 1993 of the Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievance and Pension, Department of Personnel and Training as amended by that Department vide O.M. No.36033/3/2004-Estt. (Res) dated 9th march, 2004 and any other modifications that may take place from time to time in this regard.
- (xiii) CEIs which have completed the process of admission test and selection of candidates in the SC,ST and unreserved categories, should identify the 'creamy layer' on the basis of the above mentioned information from among the successful wait-listed candidates belonging to the OBCs as per the Central List and, thereafter, offer admission to eligible candidates. For the purpose of identification, candidates would be required to furnish information on each of the criteria as per the prevailing rule of exclusion of the socially advanced persons (creamy layer). Please ensure that no ineligible person belonging to the 'creamy layer' derives the benefit of reservation. After completion of this process, information in respect of successful and eligible candidates belonging to the OBC category being offered admission may also be intimated to the UGC.
- (xiv) Each CEI is also authorized to fix cut off marks for admission / selection through admission test, etc. for the OBC candidates with such differential from the cut-off marks for the unreserved category as each institution may deem appropriate for maintaining the standards of education and at the same time ensuring that sufficient number of eligible OBC candidates are available in keeping with the directions / observations of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in this regard. This authorization by the Central Government to the CEIs to fix the cut-off marks is in compliance with the Apex Court's direction asking the Central Government to examine the feasibility of determining such cut-off marks. The Central Government believes that each CEI would ensure that the directions / observations of the Hon'ble Court are followed.
- (xv) CEIs which are in the process of conducting admission tests may decide on the cut-off marks for the OBC category well in time, so that consistent with the standards of education of the CEIs, sufficient number of eligible OBC

candidates are available for selection on the basis of inter-se merit against the reserved seats. Such institutions may also obtain information pertaining to the background of students who may have indicated as belonging to the OBC category in the application form, so as to identify those belonging to the 'creamy layer' from among them for exclusion from the counseling / interviews / group discussions / offer of admissions.

(xvi) CEIs which are yet to come out with application forms for admission may expeditiously insert the rule of exclusion / criteria of exclusion for the creamy layer, so that at the application stage itself the creamy layer could be identified, and only eligible candidates belonging to the OBC category are considered for the subsequent selection process and admissions against the reserved seats.

(xvii) Central Educational Institutions which are yet to advertise the process of selection and admissions, shall ensure that the attention of candidates intending to apply against the reserved seats is directed to the mechanism mentioned in the preceding sub-paragraphs.

4. The allocation for the first year will be **Rs.1.55 Crores**. The Commission has already released 50% of allocated outlay of your university for the year 2008-2009 and as such, you are required to ensure the proper implementation of OBCs reservation in admissions from this academic year and also ensure that the utilisation certificate of grants received by your university is submitted to the UGC on time so as to enable UGC to consider release of next instalment after meeting the stipulation made under para 3 above.

This is in continuation to this office letter No.F.24-26/2009 (CU) dated 15th May, 2009 about the intimation of XI Plan allocation of your University. I am grateful to you for the cooperation extended for furnishing the information required by the UGC.

Based on the priorities indicated by you, as well as the availability of funds from Govt. of India, UGC has approved the final XI Plan allocation of Rs.6405.00 lakh under General Development Grant. It excludes the allocation for Regional Centres. The allocation for Regional Centres will be conveyed separately after receiving the approval of the Visitor. However, the release of grant would be subject to availability of funds received from Govt. of India.

The XI plan allocation under General Development Grant for your University along with the detailed breakup is given in the enclosed statements duly signed by the undersigned. A copy of the Visiting Committee Report has already been given to you in the meeting held in the UGC Office.

The UGC has already finalized the guidelines for the schemes to be operated in the XI Plan. These guidelines are posted on the UGC website www.ugc.ac.in. I would request you to browse the UGC website regularly to keep yourself abreast of the latest XI Plan guidelines finalized by the UGC.

The University may follow the procedure for constructions of buildings strictly as prescribed in the UGC guidelines. The Building Committee should be constituted strictly as per UGC guidelines and the constitution of the Committee should be intimated to UGC.

The University may follow strictly the Government of India/UGC's guidelines regarding implementation of the reservation policy [both vertical (for SCs, STs & OBCs) and horizontal (for persons with disability etc.)], in teaching and non-teaching posts.

The teaching posts as approved by the UGC in the existing departments may be filled up in a phased manner as per requirement of the University. The teaching posts for the new proposed departments may be filled up on the basis of intake of students admitted in the University. The revised proposal for non-teaching staff has not been received so far. The same will be considered separately by the Committee constituted for this purpose and will be communicated to you.

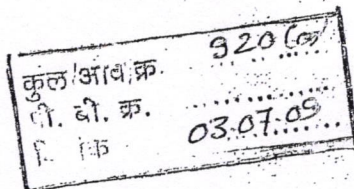
I hope the university must have also initiated the Academic Reforms as already circulated by the UGC vide its D.O.No.F.1-2/2008 (XI Plan) dated 31st January, 2008. It may also be ensured that the university has adopted the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree), Regulations, 2009.

In the end, I would request you to ensure that the utilization of the grants received by the university shall be submitted to the UGC in time to enable smooth management of funds and to avoid unnecessary audit objections.

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

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


