

# INSTITUTIONAL STRENGTH

- MGAHV, a residential university, is situated in the centre of the nation at Wardha in the Vidarbha region of Maharashtra state. This is the only Central University in the state of Maharashtra and well connected by road rail & air.
- The University holds well-established and enriched infrastructure i.e., buildings, residential blocks, separate hostels for boys & girls, laboratories (computer & language), sports facilities, health center, shopping complex, museum/archive etc.
- The University has a rich central library with good number of books, Journals and E-Resources with updated techno systems.
- The University has three schools of Language, Literature and Translation & Interpretation with different degree programmes to promote and develop Hindi Language & Literature. In addition to this there are five other schools to develop Hindi language as medium of instruction for higher learning.
- The University has adopted NEP:2020 in toto from 2021-22. It has also initiated Centre for Trans-Disciplinary Advanced Research and Knowledge -creation, Indian Translation Consortium, Social Policy Research Cell etc. to implement the NEP:2020 and create knowledge content in Hindi & other Indian languages.
- All the programmes are futuristic, multi-disciplinary and based on employability. These programmes have incorporated value-added courses related to constitutional values and national integration etc.
- The University has also its publication division, which has published 119 titles till date. It also publishes very reputed Journals in Hindi academia titled 'Bahuvachan' and 'PustakVarta'.
- The University has developed and provided different types of resources for Hindi fraternity through its web portal. This is most popular Hindi resource, having more than 10 lakh pages and growing day by day. This is most visited and cited web portal of Hindi Language and Literature across the globe.
- The University is offering different types of programmes for international students in Hindi for last 15 years. It has more than dozen MoUs with different Universities of Asia and Europe.
- The University conducts its academic programmes in the both modes of learning-Conventional and Distance.
- The University has a unique scheme of 'Writer-in-Residence'. In this scheme university invites scholars and writers of repute known for their experience, knowledge and wisdom.
- MGAHV is having a good local connect by its different activities and involvement of local population.
- The campus of the university is totally environment friendly and gradually improving green environment by their eco-friendly activities.

## INSTITUTIONALWEAKNESS

- Though the University is well connected by road, rail and air, but the University is situated in rural district headquarter at Wardha. So, the people from different distant areas of country and metropolitan cities often avoid to choose the University for their studies or academic interaction.
- Due to above reason the number of admissions of the national and international students is low and many of the seats of different programmes fall vacant.
- Being a Language University, the University-Industry linkage is weak and the opportunity for patent is also low.
- Alumni involvement in the development of the university is poor but the Alumni Association is registered and office bearers are trying their best to get maximum involvement of Alumni.
- The medium of instruction and examination is Hindi, so the participation of local and other parts of Maharashtra state is not very good. The medium of instruction and examination in the state of Maharashtra is generally either Marathi or English.
- The University was started with 04 Schools, but now it has 08 approved Schools; The sanctioned posts of teaching and non-teaching staff are not sufficient for the smooth functioning of the programmes of different departments under these schools.

## INSTITUTIONALOPPORTUNITY

- To develop as a Nodal agency for teaching, learning, consultancy and training in different dimensions of Hindi Language, Literature, Translation, Language Technology, Comparative Literature, Media Studies etc.
- To develop quality study materials for various disciplines of knowledge in Hindi and other Indian languages.
- Collaborations with academic institutions for research and academic interaction. The university has adopted dual degree programmes declared by UGC as opportunity in future.
- To develop MOOCS/SWAYAM/Online courses in Hindi for various disciplines. The University has the mandate to establish its centers/off shore campuses in any part of India and abroad.

- MGAHV has initiated Five year integrated graduate programme in Law in Hindi medium and proposed to start it in five other Indian languages also.
- The University has also the opportunities to conduct Hindi language, Translation and Interpretation programmes for the foreign nationals/officials/ diplomats. For this purpose, the university has signed MoU with ICCR, New Delhi for all the online Hindi certificate and short-term programmes. MGAHV is also working with the I-TEC division of Ministry of External Affairs, Govt. of India for Hindi Language, Translation and Interpretation courses for the different groups.
